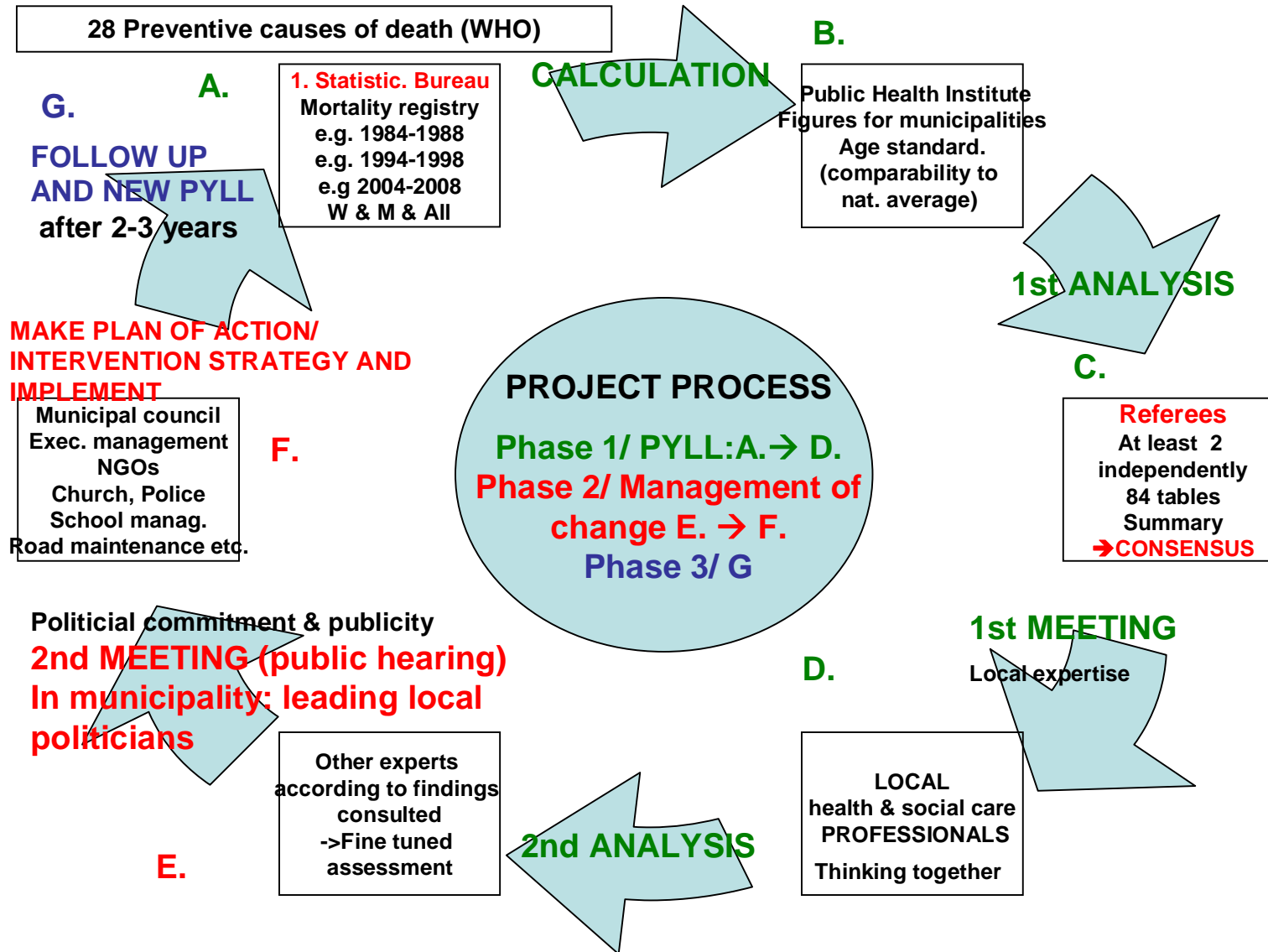

**WP4** Dissemination of PYLL practise

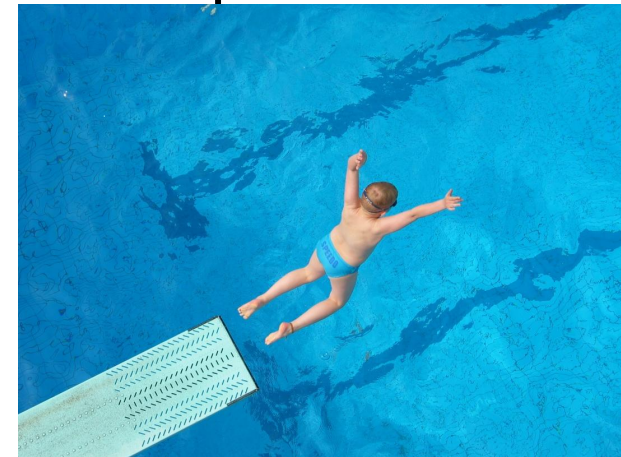

# Setting up of the System for Measuring PYLL and Analysis of the Results

- WP1 leader: University of Eastern Finland
- Expected results:
  - 1) A model of a reliable death register
  - 2) Analytical programme for calculation of PYLL rates
  - 3) Reporting system for PYLL-rates
  - 4) Analysis of the results

# Formulation of Strategic Intervention Plan

- **WP2 leader:** Baltic Region Healthy Cities Association
- **Expected results:**
  - 1) Strategic plan for overcoming preventable premature mortality and morbidity
  - 2) Adoption of strategic intervention plan based on consensus meetings with stakeholders
  - 3) 2 consensus meetings held

# Implementation of Action: Management of Change

- **WP3 leader:** The NGO Development Centre
- **Expected results:**
  - 1) Implementation of action with highest possible health gain in the target population
  - 2) 6 information-consultation meetings and 2 seminars held
